Useful Expression 2

In today's scene, Ms. Gruwell says, I'm a teacher. **It doesn't matter** what color I am.

The expressions **no matter what**, and **it doesn't matter** are two different expressions. **No matter what** refers to anything and everything. Whereas **it doesn't matter** ... means that something is unimportant or irrelevant.

It doesn't matter what color I am means that the color of my skin is not important (is irrelevant).

-It doesn`t matter if you approve or not. (It doesn`t matter whether you approve or not.) (It doesn`t matter what you think.) (It doesn`t matter what your opinion is.)
